Volunteer Parent Job Descriptions

Food Stand (12) – This position requires 3 people to help for about 1/3 of the meet to serve food and drinks. With this job, you may leave and come up on deck to watch your child swim. We do not want you to miss your swimmer while volunteering in this area.

Runners (4) – Runners, collect the time slips from the timers and take them to the scoring area. This position is for ½ of the meet. This easy job gets you on deck and near all the action!

Timers (12) – This task requires you to use a stop watch. (Start at the light flash and stop when the swimmer touches the wall). You will be on deck and most likely will get wet as you are stationed at the finish of each race to capture the swimmers times. This position is for ½ of the meet. This is a fun place to be as this is the closest you can get to the water.

Scoring (4) – This area is the computer scoring of every home meet and the Frosty Frolic invitational. This task requires data entry into a computer system on the 25-yard events, longer events are auto entered by the Colorado touch pads. A lot of this area is a Quality Control to be sure the times are correct when entering into the system. Other functions are printing materials as needed for coaches at the start of the meet. Printing ribbon labels for the ribbon people. This position is for ½ of the meet.

Ribbons (2) – This job starts when the meet is about half over. This will be until the completion of the meet and all labels are placed. Ribbons are placed in separate bags for each team.

Announcer (2) – This person would use the microphone to announce all the kids swimming in each event. This position is for ½ of the meet.

Finish Judge (2) – These people would watch the finish of each race and report the finish of each race as they saw it. Some of these races are very close and your results are compared to other officials to determine the winner. This position is for ½ of the meet.

***Official (4)** – This position requires training and certification. It includes Starter and Stroke & Turn judges. Past swimming experience is helpful for parents that may want to help out with this.

Clerk or Course (4) – These people line up the kids so that they get to their correct lane on time. This position is for entire meet.

Team Building (6) – This group will be creative in bringing the team together for special projects such as (Swim-a-thon, other fun group activities to help build the team). The Swin-a-thon is our only fundraiser that we hold each year. The swimmers try to swim as many laps that they can in the 2 hour time period. This committee will find new ways to get all swimmers to want to participate. This is one way we help hold down costs on registrations. A board member will lead this group.

Sponsorship (3) – This committee will work to solicit businesses to sponsor our team. The President of the club will head this committee.
